Helpful Facts

Accessible Parking:

- Located in designated spots along SHS Drive.

Entrance:

- Wheelchair-accessible entrance along SHS Drive.
- Accessible automatic door at the entrance.

Washrooms:

- There are two accessible bathrooms onsite - notably the one near the Principal's Office is the best option.

Interior:

- Wide hallways with space to easily manoeuvre.
- Accessible seating options are available for participants with mobility disabilities upon request (i.e. designated seating, easy access to enter/exit, aisle seating).
